1. Subject: Consider Resolution Authorizing the Purchase of Snow Plow Truck Equipment Package

Background:

The City Council authorized the replacement of a Snow Plow Truck and Equipment in the amount of \$218,565.00 when adopting the 2022 budget. This vehicle would be replacing the 2007 Sterling snow plow truck. Council already approved the plow truck at the May 3rd Council meeting and the remaining is the equipment package. Staff received state contract pricing for the snowplow equipment package in the amount of \$150,078.00. Due to unforeseen price increases when including the budgeted CIP amount the truck and equipment package are \$47,002.64 overbudget. The finance Director will make the necessary budget adjustments with the funding source was identified as Streets (500). Delaying the purchase of the snow plow truck equipment package would result in the new snow plow being inoperable for the 2022-2023 season to wait until next year to purchase the package; J-Craft is projecting the package would be higher if we wait.

Background

Isanti Firefighters Rodeo Association has submitted a special event permit application to host a five-day PRCA Rodeo event to be held at the Isanti Firefighters Rodeo Association Grounds on July 9, 10, 2022. With three days of set-up prior to the event.

No road closures are being requested, but "Slow Crossing" sign on 3rd and 1st Ave are being requested as well as possible orange traffic cones for the cross walk between Isanti Primary School and Unity Park.

Additional parking will be needed for event. A map included with the event requests the use of parking at the following locations: Isanti Primary School, Unity Park and Unity Park Ballfield, BMX blacktop/grass area, Isanti Firefighters Rodeo Grounds, West Side of Police/Fire Station Grass. City Staff did discuss the use of the BMX blacktop and grass area for parking, and due to the use agreement with BMX would recommend against the use of those parking areas for this event.

An outdoor audio system will be used for the announcer of the rodeo for both days, as well as a live band on both Friday and Saturday nights.

Five (5) additional restrooms will be brought in.

The complete application along with departmental review are attached.

Submitted with the Special Event Permit Application was a request for Waiver of fees for the following: \$100 cleanup deposit fee and the \$50 Temporary Sign Permit Application Fee.

The Isanti Firefighter Rodeo Association is also requesting to waive the proof of written notification to property owners within 350 feet of the event, as they are heavily advertising this large event on social media, paper flyers, radio stations, signs and parade trucks.



Subject: Amendment to Fairway Greens North Development Agreements for Phase I and Phase

II

The City of Isanti started receiving building permit applications for the Fairway Greens North Phase I development. Through the staff's review of the permits and the requirements of the PUD it has come to our attention that the lot sizes do not allow for the 720 sq. ft. garages required of the R-1 Single Family Residential District. In all other PUDs within the district the garage minimums are set at 600 sq. ft. City Staff recommend amending the Development Agreement to coincide with the precedent set throughout all of the existing PUDs in the R-1 Single Family Residential District which will fit within the setbacks of the lot sizes within the development. We recommend this change for both phases that have been approved for this development.

Additionally, there are few smaller lots platted in the development labeled "villa lots." These homes are required to be slab on grad patio homes. Due to the lot size and setback requirements, we are requesting these lots as identified in the attached resolutions have a minimum garage requirement of 400 sq. ft., which is the standard for lots of this nature throughout the City of Isanti.
