#### **K.** Business Items

#### 1. School District Strategic Plan

Dr. Ray Queener, the Superintendent for the Cambridge-Isanti School District, was present and reviewed with the City Council the School District's strategic plan. Dr. Queener reviewed the implementation of the strategic plan, measuring objectives, and progress reports - which will be placed online for everyone to be able to view. Dr. Queener also updated the Council on the School District's new mission statement.

Mayor Wimmer noted that the City has a good relationship with the School District. Mayor Wimmer stated that a strong school district is important from an economic development standpoint.

#### 2. Community Veteran Services

Jim Rostberg, a representative for Veteran Services, was present and updated the City Council on programs available to veterans. Rostberg reviewed state programs and some of the Veteran Affairs (VA) Departments. Rostberg reviewed: VA Benefits Administration, VA Health Administration, the VA National Cemetery System, and VA War Pension. Rostberg also reviewed programs for service connected disability, education, loan guarantees, and the Beyond the Yellow Ribbon Program in Isanti County.

Mayor Wimmer noted that Rostberg is very willing to help out anyone with questions and that he is a great resource and community liaison.

#### 3. Explorer Program

Isanti County Sheriff, Chris Caulk, was present along with Chief Gene Hill, City Police Officer Adam Gau, County Deputy Chad Meyer, and Police Explorers Paul Elmstrand, Tanner Hagen, and Logan Deline. Caulk and Hill explained the benefits of the Police Explorer program and how it benefits the youth and the community. This program offers youth ages 14-21 a great resource for career exploration/ development and training. Explorers help out significantly around the community for events such as ATV and snowmobile safety training courses, the rodeo, parades, National Night Out, and Take a Kid Fishing. Gau and Meyer noted the Isanti Explorers took first place in a Hostile Negotiations competition and third place in a Traffic Stop competition. Explorer Elmstrand further explained the explorer program and how it works for youth.

Collison asked how someone could donate to the explorer program. Caulk explained that a check can be made out to Isanti County - and to notate within the memo line that it is for the explorer program.
