Please read carefully before signing.

1. I seek permission from the City of Isanti, Minnesota (the "City") to metal detect on the property at _____ (the "Activity") on _____ (date(s)).
2. My participation in the Activity is voluntary. I know and am aware of all the dangers associated with my participation in this Activity. Said risks may include injury or accident to person (including death) or property or other loss, and I freely, voluntarily, and with such knowledge assume any and all such risks while performing the Activity.
3. I agree to remove any and all trash found in connection with metal detecting this property and to not leave any areas disturbed due to this Activity.
I agree to follow all State and Federal laws including but not limited to not detecting on or near any sacred area or area having archaeological importance.
4. I will follow the Metal Detecting Minnesota groups Code of Ethics.
5. I understand the City will have the first right of refusal for items of historical or monetary significance.
6. I understand the City has the right to limit access to metal detect in certain areas within City property.
7. I understand and agree that neither the City nor any person acting on behalf of the City, may be held liable in any way for any event which occurs in connection with this Activity which may result in harm, death, injury or other damage to me. This waiver of liability does not waive liability for any injuries that I obtain as the result of willful, wanton or intentional misconduct by the City or any person acting on behalf of the City.
8. I agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City for any expense or liability the City may incur as a result of my conduct, actions or omissions while performing the Activity.



The Metal Detecting Minnesota group Code of Ethics:

1. I will always seek and gain permission on all private property before detecting there.
2. I will observe all laws whether national, state or local and will aid law enforcement whenever possible.
3. I will leave all gates, doors or any other means of entry as I found them.
4. I will not contaminate areas such as wells, creeks, rivers, lakes or any land.
5. I will replace any and all excavated ground to its original look as to leave little or no sign of my presence.
6. I will not tamper with any posted signs, structures and equipment.
7. I will report the discovery of any item of possible historical significance to the proper authorities.
8. I will report the discovery of any dangerous items such as but not limited to weapons and or lethal or toxic items to the proper authorities.
9. I will never detect in an area considered historical, near landmarks of significance or cemeteries.
10. I will always respect my fellow detectorists by never revealing their search locations without prior consent to do so; I will also respect and keep private any information my fellow detectorist asks me to do so.
11. As a detectorist I will be judged by example and will always conduct myself with courtesy and consideration for others, I will be helpful and informative when I can be and will respect the feelings and rights of others at all times
